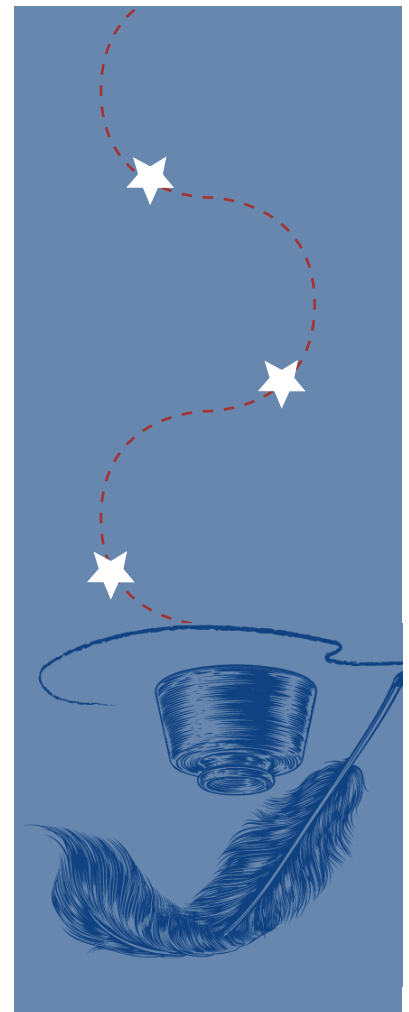


A scavenger hunt in celebration of the first state & first star!

Prizes will include gift certificates to restaurants throughout the state, special museum experiences, and more.

Winning entries will be randomly selected the week of January 6, with the winners to be announced by Friday, January 10. Winners will be contacted to schedule prize pickup.
